Assessment Methodology

- SFWMD pilot study (2007-2008)
- The pilot study methodology was modified
- Each district selected wetland assessment sites within their area
- Contractors and district staff collected wetland data

Assessment Methodology

- Wetland assessment databases (shapefile and KML/KMZ) were created
- Wetland assessment data were evaluated to determine
 - Physical alterations
 - Hydrologic stress
- Identify relationship between wetland stress and model output (in progress)

Assessment Sites

- Identified more than 600 sites for assessment
- Collected data at more than 450 sites
- More than 350 sites had data suitable for our analysis and included in the databases

Public Records Request Meeting

- Met with STOPR group of utilities consultants on March 15^{th,} 2011 to answer questions regarding their public records request.
- Will meet again on April 13th (9:30 am noon) and May 4th (1:30 – 3:30 pm) at the SFWMD St. Cloud Field Station to discuss methods, data, and results of the CFCA environmental assessment.
