- More emphasis on DMIT recommendations
- Water Conservation
 - Historical conservation should be more strongly reflected
 - Statewide water conservation clearinghouse
- Project cost estimates


“Next Steps” added to Executive Summary


- Support Development and Implementation of Regional Project Solutions

October


- Steering Committee Meeting
