## CENTRAL FLORIDA WATER INITIATIVE REGULATORY TEAM MEETING

**JULY 28, 2016** 

The Central Florida Water Initiative (CFWI) Regulatory Team held a meeting at 1:00 9.m. on Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup> via Teleconference.

- 1. <u>Call to Order:</u> The meeting was called to order. The meeting introductory statement was read and a roll call of Team members was taken.
- 2. Review of Previous Meetings: The meeting summary from 7/15 has been distributed. No additional discussion.
- 3. Review of CFWI at Summer School: CFWI was featured at Summer School at its oen panel as well as mentions at several others. Positive feedback from the Steering Committee was provided to the Team at meeting held in conjunction with Summer School.

## 4. CFWI Consistency:

- Schedule of topics Current calendar distributed dated 7/28/16. A revised table will be distributed based on this meeting.
- Topics:
  - Uniform demand agriculture Update given on Phase 2 testing of AFSIRS. Comparisons will be made between AFSIRS and existing model outputs based on average rainfall conditions to avoid level of certainty discussion at this time. Default input values are being set in terms of irrigation efficiency, crop coefficients, soils, etc. Rainfall station data continues to be evaluated. Rules options may be available by the end of August. Phase 3 testing can provide level of certainty ranges by the end of the year.
  - Uniform definition of harm Comments received from a number of stakeholders, more anticipated to come in. Updated concepts will be provided in time for review and discussion at the face to face meeting. Commenters provided a high-level overview of questions and edits submitted to date.
- 5. <u>Pending Permit Applications:</u> Updated distributed for June. Comments made on the low increases in allocations compared to previous efforts to total permits. Previous estimates were based on a synthesis of monthly pending applications, not actual permits. Districts will review totals for accuracy.
- **6.** Open Discussion and Public Comment: Additional discussions took place following up from the previous meeting on rulemaking format for draft options as well as the need for support from the Environmental Measures Team and Hydrologic Analysis Team in our efforts. It was requested these issues be included in the 8/19 meeting agenda.
- 7. Review agenda items for future meetings: The next Reg Team call is set for August 3<sup>rd</sup> at 1 p.m. and the face to face meeting is scheduled for August 19<sup>th</sup> at 10 a.m. in Maitland.
