- Paul Gray, Audubon
 - If we implement the projects listed in the plan will we see impacts to the MFLs listed as harmed?

 - Comments regarding WSIS study, St Johns River withdrawals, consequences of withdrawals outside of the CFWI Planning Area, and the plan does not capture harm to springs.

 - How will projects be implemented? How will groundwater be optimized and are the projects local or regional? Will there be an action plan? How will projects be funded?
