



Register for the 2025 CFWI Regional Water Supply Plan Virtual Steering Committee and Public Meeting

The 2025 Central Florida Water Initiative (CFWI) Regional Water Supply Plan (RWSP) Work Group will be holding a virtual Steering Committee and Public Meeting Wednesday, April 23, 2025, at 9 a.m. The meeting will include a presentation of the results, conclusions, and recommendations of the draft 2025 CFWI RWSP.

Staff with the St. Johns River, South Florida, and Southwest Florida water management districts (Districts) posted the draft 2025 CFWI RWSP for public review on March 14, 2025. The final 2025 CFWI RWSP is scheduled for presentation to and anticipated approval by the governing boards of the respective Districts by the end of 2025.

The CFWI Planning Area consists of all of Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Polk counties and southern Lake County, covering approximately 5,300 square miles. The 2025 CFWI RWSP will identify existing and projected water needs as well as projects and funding sources to meet those needs over the next 20 years.
