Reminder to Register for the 2025 CFWI Regional Water Supply Plan Steering Committee and Public Meeting

The 2025 Central Florida Water Initiative (CFWI) Regional Water Supply Plan (RWSP) Work Group will be holding a virtual Steering Committee and Public Meeting Monday, Oct. 14, 2024, at 1 p.m. The virtual meeting will include a presentation of the draft results of the 2025 CFWI RWSP.

Staff with the St. Johns, Southwest, and South Florida water management districts (Districts) are in the process of preparing the five-year update to the 2020 CFWI RWSP. The draft 2025 CFWI RWSP is anticipated to be available for public review in early 2025. The final 2025 CFWI RWSP is scheduled to be approved by the governing boards of the Districts by the end of 2025.

The CFWI Planning Area consists of all of Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Polk counties and southern Lake County, covering approximately 5,300 square miles. The 2025 CFWI RWSP will identify existing and projected water needs as well as projects and funding sources to meet those needs over the next 20 years.
