Water by the Numbers

- Most of the water people use in their homes swirls down the toilet bowl. The average high-volume toilet flush in Florida uses 5 gallons of water. Newer, low-flow models use as little as 1.6 gallons per flush.
- The average shower uses 8 gallons of water a minute. A low-flow showerhead uses 2.5 gallons per minute or less.
- Filling a bathtub takes about 36 gallons of water. Taking a bath with the tub half full uses about 18 gallons.
- Faucets, generally use 2.5 gallons a minute. Low-flow models use as little as 1.5 gallons per minute.
- Dishwashers generally use 11 gallons per load in most cases; that's less than when you wash dishes by hand.
- Older washing machines use up to 40 gallons of water per load. Newer, water-saving models use only 18 gallons of water per load.
- Watering the yard sometimes accounts for 25 percent to 50 percent of all residential water use. A hose is capable of spraying 12 gallons of water per minute.
- If you wash a car and leave the hose running, you waste more than 540 gallons of water. If you use a trigger nozzle, bucket, and rag, you use roughly 120 gallons of water.
