The Challenges — Teacher Resources

Where's the Water Going?



Materials

- Drawing paper
- Markers
- Colored pencils

Procedures

- 1. Ask students to draw a picture of their school, home, or apartment, including all the water sources that supply running water to their homes or are found nearby (include groundwater, lakes, rivers, streams, etc.).
- 2. Discuss the importance of protecting and conserving these sources of water.
- 3. Take a class walk around the school campus, noting all the water sources available (water fountains, sinks, etc.).
- 4. Make a list of areas around the school where students noted that water is being wasted.
- 5. Brainstorm suggestions for conserving water in these areas.
- 6. As a class, students might wish to make a recommendation to the principal on ways to save water in these areas.
