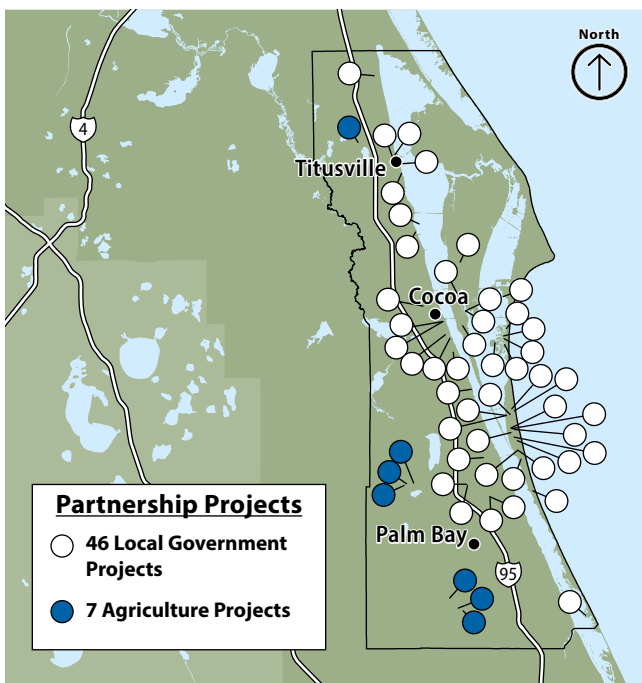


PROTECTING BREVARD COUNTY THROUGH LOCAL PROJECTS



The St. Johns River Water Management District (District) works with local partners to preserve and protect Florida's water resources. Together, we support projects that improve water quality, conserve water, restore natural areas, and reduce flooding risks. These efforts deliver measurable benefits, including nutrient load reductions, increased storage capacity, expanded alternative water supplies, conservation outcomes, and flood protection improvements.





MAXIMIZING LOCAL BENEFITS

The District, in partnership with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, has awarded nearly **\$28.3 million** in cost-share funding for projects throughout Brevard County, including agriculture projects. When combined with local matching funds, these investments total approximately **\$97.3 million**.

The resulting projects have achieved:

- **0.641 million gallons per day** of water conserved
- **2.5 million gallons** of storage capacity
- **186,908 pounds per year (lbs/year)** of total nitrogen reduction
- **17,505 lbs/year** of total phosphorus reduction
- **1.13 acres** of wetland improvements
