As a result of questions from potential bidders, the following clarifications/additional information is provided.

When are Best Management Practices (BMP) updated? According to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the BMPs are ideally updated every five years. The most recent cattle manual from 2008 is currently going through the review process. After enrollment, a site visit is conducted every other year.

The District is still working on other questions that arose at the mandatory site visit so there will be an Addendum #3.
