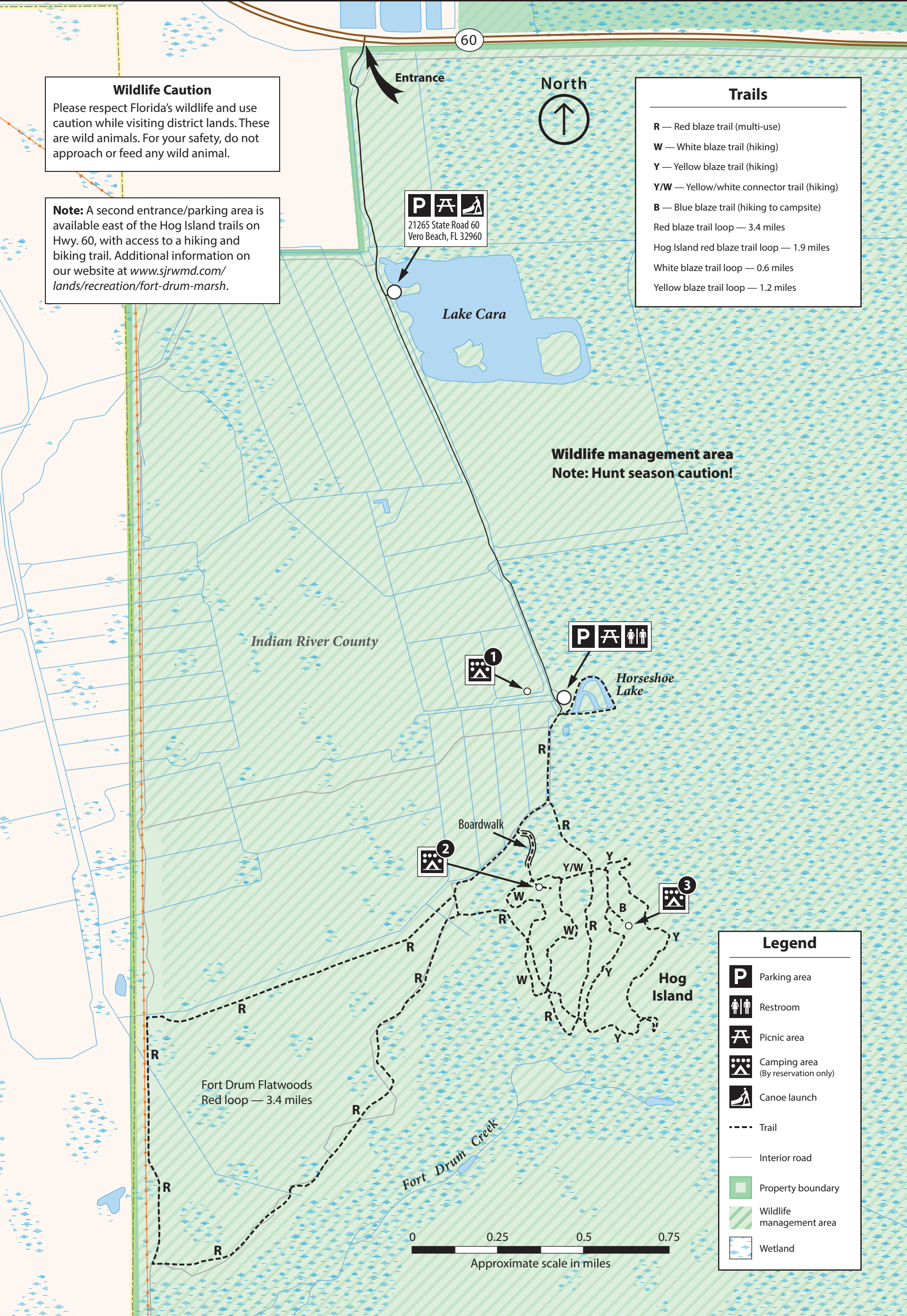




Fort Drum Marsh Conservation Area

Trails

- R** — Red blaze trail (multi-use)
- W** — White blaze trail (hiking)
- Y** — Yellow blaze trail (hiking)
- Y/W** — Yellow/white connector trail (hiking)
- B** — Blue blaze trail (hiking to campsite)
- Red blaze trail loop — 3.4 miles
- Hog Island red blaze trail loop — 1.9 miles
- White blaze trail loop — 0.6 miles
- Yellow blaze trail loop — 1.2 miles
